Contestant Rules and Eligibility

1. This is an **OPEN PAGEANT**. Contestant does **NOT** have to be a resident of Franklin County. Open to all residents of the Commonwealth of Kentucky who have lived in the state for at least 6 months.
2. Pre-Teen contestant must have reached her 8th birthday by July 1, 2026 and shall not have reached her 13th birthday by Oct. 31, 2026. *(A copy of birth certificate must be included with application.)*
3. Former Winners of the Miss Pre-Teen Franklin County Fair are not eligible to complete.
4. Contestants may not have won, nor be entered in any other pageant system that would prohibit the fulfillment of responsibilities throughout the state should she be the winner of the Miss Pre-Teen Kentucky County Fair.
5. There will be one overall winner, Miss Pre-Teen Franklin County Fair, who will represent Franklin County at the State Kentucky County Fair Pageant in October 2026 and attend the Christmas Parade. The local winner will have the opportunity to attend fair activities and is expected to participate with the Fair Board in the Christmas Parade.
6. No one will be allowed backstage or in the dressing room at any time during the pageant. This includes parents, friends, hairstylists, etc. Everyone, except the contestants, should leave the backstage and dressing room area by 7:30 pm.
7. Please be advised that there is a \$15 admission fee into the fairgrounds. Contestant and one parent are admitted free into the fair.
8. Contestants must recognize the Judges' decision as final. Judging is based on appearance, poise, personality, and on-stage question.
9. The Pageant Committee reserves the right to dismiss at any time any contestant who does not show the proper amount of cooperation and courtesy to committee members, consultants and fellow contestants. Horseplay and other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
10. Harassment of fair and pageant officials/volunteers will not be tolerated. Parental interference during rehearsals and the pageant could be cause for participants to be dismissed. Entry fees will not be refunded.
11. All questions on application should be answered in complete sentences and typed if mailed.
12. Contestant will participate in a 3-minute interview with the judges. They should wear an age-appropriate interview outfit – anything that is best dress attire, no jeans or shorts, or strapless outfits. For on-stage intros, outfit of choice Denim 'n' Diamonds theme wear. Limited accessories can be used to help show off personality. Formal wear is long dresses - nothing strapless - and should not show shoes.
13. Rehearsal for contestants will be held on Thursday, July 9, 2025 at 6 pm EDT at the Hancock Pavilion, Lakeview Park, Frankfort. Attendance is **OPTIONAL** but **strongly** encouraged. I will be having a parent meeting to answer questions and practice with the girls.
14. We will be having a Photogenic Award this year. The contestant will need to submit an 8x10 photo by mail or online by July 6, 2026. We will have online voting along with our People's Choice awards where you raise money to help with state competition costs for the overall winner. The voting will be posted on the Franklin County Fair Facebook page (*Franklin County Fair, KY*) and Instagram page (*franklinkyfair*). So, make sure to go follow the links and be watching!
15. Registration will be accepted online at: <https://bombyhead.com/contest.php?contestid=c3467> or via mail, up until 5:00 pm EDT on July 13. Entry forms must be typed. 16. With People's Choice I will be doing it online with Bombyhead. They still have a minimum of \$10 to participate, but money will be collected and put on our account online. If a contestant chooses **NOT** to participate in the People's Choice Award and they are named the overall winner, they will **NOT** be allowed use of the funds.
 17. Contestants should arrive at the Franklin Co. Extension Office, 101 Lakeview Court, by 5:00 pm EDT on the day of the pageant dressed and ready for their interview. **This is where** interviews will be held. After their interview, contestants will go to the Hancock Pavilion at Lakeview Park. This is where the on-stage portion of the pageant will take place.
 18. There will be an overall winner—Miss Pre-Teen Franklin County Fair—who will represent the community and the Fair at the state competition. Should the overall winner be from outside Franklin County, there will be a Miss Pre-Teen Franklin County—highest scores of local contestants—to represent the Fair within the community. In this case, Miss Pre-Teen Franklin County would also be eligible to be an overall runner-up if scores are high enough.
