Miss Teen Franklin Co. Fair will receive a crown; flower bouquet; sash; a gift card from Madison Avenue Richmond; a photo package from Rob Metzger Photography; a spray tan session from Fran Wells; a gift certificate from Miss Priss; a gift card from Steaming by Nicole; a 1/2 interview session from Tiffany Porter--Journey to the Crown; a gift card from Bourbon Belles & Babes; a gift card from Big Bling on a Budget/Yolanda Gould; a gift certificate from The Copper Penny of London; and \$100 cash. First runner-up will receive a medallion and \$50. Second runner-up will receive a medallion and \$25. The first runner-up will represent Franklin County in the event the winner becomes ineligible or is unable to attend.

Contestant Rules and Eligibility

1. This is an OPEN pageant. Contestant must have been a Kentucky resident for the last 6 months.
2. Contestant must have reached her 13th birthday by Oct. 31, 2026 and shall not have reached her 16th birthday by Oct. 31, 2026. *(Born between Oct. 31, 2010 and Oct. 31, 2013.)* A copy of the contestant's birth certificate must be included with the entry form.
3. There will be an overall winner– Miss Teen Franklin County Fair– who will represent the community and the Fair at the Miss Teen Kentucky County Fair Pageant in October. The Franklin County Fair Board is responsible for her room at the MTKCF Pageant. Should the overall winner be from outside Franklin County, there will also be a Miss Teen Franklin County– highest score of local contestants – to represent Fair within the community. In this case, Miss Teen Franklin County would also be eligible to be an overall runner-up if her scores are high enough.
4. Contestants will participate in a 5-minute interview with a panel of 3 judges. Interviews will be held at the Franklin Co. Cooperative Extension Office, 101 Lakeview Dr. beginning at **2:00 pm EDT**. Contestants should wear blue jean shorts (Shorts must be BLUE jean, no rips or tears), a solid color top and white tennis shoes.
5. Contestants will introduce themselves on stage. Interview outfit should be worn. The introductions should be no more than 2-3 sentences.
6. Contestants will appear in a cocktail/party dress of their choice that shows their personality. The cocktail/party dress should be age appropriate, appropriate length and have straps. Please reference the diagram at www.kafs.net Miss Teen Contestant Info. *Contact the chair with questions.*
7. Contestants will lastly appear in a floor length formal gown for the on-stage portion of the pageant. Each contestant will answer an on-stage question in their formal wear.
8. Contestants must not have won any other preliminary competition to the 2026 Miss Teen Kentucky County Fair Pageant.
9. Contestants may not have won nor be entered in any other pageant system that would prohibit the fulfillment of responsibilities throughout the state should she be the winner of the Miss Teen Kentucky County Fair 2026.
10. Miss Teen Franklin County Fair 2026 and Miss Teen Franklin County 2026, if crowned, will be invited to participate in select activities during Fair week and encouraged to ride on the Fair Board's float in Frankfort's Christmas parade.
11. Contestants and their families agree to recognize the judges' decisions as final. Judging will be based on appearance, poise, personality, and interview.
12. The Pageant Committee reserves the right to dismiss at any time any contestant who does not show the proper amount of cooperation and courtesy to committee members, consultants, and fellow contestants. Horseplay and other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
13. Harassment of fair and pageant officials/volunteers will not be tolerated. Parental interference during rehearsal and the pageant could be cause for participants to be dismissed. Entry fees will not be refunded.
14. Pregnancy or conduct deemed unbecoming by the Pageant Committee will automatically disqualify the winner.
15. No one (parents, friends, hairstylists, coaches) will be allowed backstage or in the dressing room at any time during the pageant. Assigned staff will assist the contestants, as needed.
16. NO cameras, video cameras, or cell phones will be allowed in the dressing room.
17. All questions on the entry form should be answered in complete sentences. A copy of the entry form will be included in the judges' books. Information on the entry form might be read to the audience during the on-stage portion of the pageant.
18. Entry Fee – There will be NO REFUNDS. Entry fee should be paid in the form of a Money Order made payable to the Franklin County Fair & Horse Show or in cash or via Venmo. Please find the QR Code for Venmo at the end of these rules. The entry fee must accompany the entry form. If using Venmo for payment of

- \$50 - if received on or before July 11, 2026
- \$60 - if received on July 12, 2026, until 12 Noon ET.

19. Entry forms and the entry fee can be mailed to **Miss Teen Franklin County Fair & Horse Show, P.O. Box 4565, Frankfort, KY 40604**. Entry forms will be accepted until 12 Noon ET July 12 (*day of pageant*).
20. There will be NO rehearsal this year. Contestants and parents are welcome to call or text the chair with any questions prior to the pageant. Contestant numbers will be assigned prior to interview in the order of registration being received.
21. Peoples Choice money will be accepted in the form of cash donation or via Venmo to the Fair's account. **If submitting on Venmo, please include contestant's name and age group/pageant with your submission.** People's Choice donations will be accepted until the end of the on-stage introduction portion of pageant. If a contestant chooses NOT to participate in the People's Choice Award and they are named the winner, they will NOT be allowed use of the funds. For further questions, please contact the chair.
22. This is a stand-alone event; NO RIDES will be operating. There will be no gate admission fee.
23. The Franklin County Fair Board and all of its agents and volunteers cannot be held responsible for accidents, injury, or loss of personal property relating to this event.
